### **Directions to Heath Farm, Heath Lane, Godalming, Surrey. GU7 1UN**

### **SAT NAV USERS PLEASE NOTE DIRECTIONS BELOW**

We are located on the B2130 Godalming to Cranleigh Road, just outside Godalming.

**If coming from the M25**, go south down the A3 PAST all Guildford turnings (IGNORE SAT NAV as it will take you through the middle of Guildford). Take the turning to Godalming and Guildford Crematorium.

Take signs to Godalming Town Centre and then pick up signs for Cranleigh (B2130).

At the traffic lights between Homebase and Waitrose in Godalming go straight on. At the next set of traffic lights turn left onto the B2130 (sign posted Cranleigh and Winkworth Arboretum). Go up hill past all the parked cars and over speed bumps.

At the pedestrian crossing by the church slow down, go over one more speed bump and turn left into Heath Lane (IGNORE SAT NAV as it will take you straight on). It is very narrow (but plenty big enough for a horsebox) and is very easy to go straight past. Go down the lane and take the first left into Heath Farm.

**If coming north on the A3**, come off at the Milford exit. Follow signs for Godalming. Pick up signs for Cranleigh and the B2130. Turn right at the second large set of traffic lights in Godalming onto the B2130 (signposted Cranleigh and Winkworth Arboretum). Follow directions as above.

**If coming from Horsham on the A281**, follow signs for Godalming and approach from the Godalming direction. The turn into Heath Farm from the Cranleigh end of the B2130 is blind and is too tight for a lorry without doing a three point turn in the middle of the road!

**ALL DOGS ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES PLEASE. Any dogs seen off leads will have to be removed from the competition site.**

**YOU MUST SUPPLY YOUR OWN NUMBER BIBS. Number inserts to be collected from the Secretary on the day.**

## **RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. Your signature on the entry form shall be construed as acceptance of these rules.
2. **All competitors must ensure that they have adequate public liability insurance in place before competing/coming to the show.**
3. Entries made without the appropriate fee will not be accepted. No telephone entries.
4. The committee reserve the right to refuse or cancel the entry(s) made by any person if they shall deem it fit to do so, without giving reason. Also the right to cancel class or classes refunding any fees in respect thereof and to amalgamate any sections in which there are insufficient entries.
5. BHS RIDING CLUB RULES APPLY. The decision of the judge(s) and organisers is final.
6. Declared order – Competitors must compete in the order declared at the collecting ring.
7. Starting – If the judge is dissatisfied with the rate at which competitors present themselves, he may issue a public warning. At the end of a 3 minute interval, he may issue a 2<sup>nd</sup> public warning and at the end of a further 3 minutes, declare the competition closed.
8. Horses / ponies may only be ridden once in any one class and in no more than 2 classes in total. They must be 4 years or older and only those competing may be ridden on the showground.
9. No competitor may practice over any part of the course. If seen doing so, they will be eliminated.
10. Practice jumps must be jumped from the correct side – they will be flagged white flag to the left, red to the right. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
11. Misuse of whips or spurs may result in elimination.
12. Hats – All riders must wear correctly fitting approved protective headgear conforming to ASTM, PAS015, SEI or Snell E2001, carrying the BSI Kite mark, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points and with NO FIXED PEAK. Headgear must be worn and correctly fastened AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED. Riders hair should be neatly and firmly secured so it is no longer than shoulder length.
13. Body protectors and arm bands are compulsory on the cross country section. Correct riding dress must be worn including light coloured jodhpurs or breeches, correct footwear, i.e. long boots or short boots with matching plain coloured half chaps. Cross country colours may be worn in the XC section **with your body protector over the top.**
14. Elimination – (See BRC Rule book) Any competitor eliminated must leave the course immediately at a walk without attempting further jumps.
15. Give way – Any competitor in difficulty at a fence must give way to following competitors who wish to overtake.
16. No horse or pony to be left unattended unless secured inside the lorry / trailer.
17. Respect the show ground – Do not skip out lorries / trailers on to the field.
18. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
19. Any objection must be accompanied by a deposit of £20 and made in writing to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.
20. Membership of the club is determined by the status of the rider, rather than the owner of the horse /pony. Entrants who are not members of the HRRC will be deemed as associated members for the day of the competition.
21. Disclaimer of liability – Organisers or Landowners shall not be liable for any claim for loss or damage to competitors, onlookers, their servants, horses, other animals, vehicles, equipment or any other item in connection with the show or on the showground, however caused. Competitors are to satisfy themselves they have assessed the risk factor in competing and it is a condition of entry that each participant will satisfy themselves as to their own ability to ride safely and indemnify the organisers against any accident or loss, however caused.
22. Health and safety – Reasonable precautions will be taken to ensure the health and safety of all persons present. In order for these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and obey the instructions of Organisers, Officials and Stewards at all times. The Organisers reserve the right that any person whose conduct is detrimental to the character and interest of the show, may be asked to leave and may be subject to disciplinary proceedings.
